

MANUFACTURER'S DECLARATION

with regard to

**Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council
of 18 December 2006**

concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), establishing a European Chemicals Agency, amending Directive 1999/45/EC and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 793/93 and Commission Regulation (EC) No 1488/94 as well as Council Directive 76/769/EEC and Commission Directives 91/155/EEC, 93/67/EEC, 93/105/EC and 2000/21/EC.

With the REACH regulation, the EU has created a uniform system for the **Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals** – called **REACH** for short. The purpose of this regulation is to guarantee a high degree of protection for human health and the environment.

Franz Binder GmbH & Co. Elektrische Bauelemente KG herewith confirms that it acts in accordance with the above-mentioned regulation as a downstream user (producer of articles).

We source all raw materials and/or preparations used to produce connectors from suppliers which have already registered or preregistered all substances, including those contained in preparations. The products delivered by our company are not subject to registration.

With regard to Article 33, paragraph 1 of the REACH regulation, Franz Binder GmbH & Co. Elektrische Bauelemente KG fulfils its obligation of disclosure:

An updated candidate list (list of the substances of very high concern for authorisation, status **15/1/2019**, see <https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>) pursuant to Article 59 (1, 10) of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH) has been published. Many of our standard articles delivered contain a substance included in the current candidate list in concentrations above a percentage by weight of 0.1%:

- Lead (Pb) (CAS 7439-92-1, EC 231-100-4)
- Imidazolidine-2-thione (C₃H₆N₂S) (CAS:96-45-7, EC 202-506-9)
